1. Overview

The Workshop on “Cyber Jagrukta Diwas” was organized on 01 November 2025 at Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Language University, Lucknow, by the Department of Computer Science and Engineering. The objective of the programme was to promote cyber awareness, digital responsibility, and data security practices among students and faculty members.

The event brought together academic leaders, industry experts, and university officials to discuss the growing importance of cybersecurity, privacy protection, ethical engineering practices, and skill-based career development in the digital age. Distinguished guests shared insights on transparency in knowledge, integrity in technological development, and the responsibility of engineers to safeguard user data and system reliability.

The workshop also emphasized the need for practical skills over mere degrees, emerging opportunities in the field of data security, and modern security approaches such as the Zero Trust Policy. University leadership highlighted the institution's commitment to strengthening technical infrastructure, including plans for a new computer laboratory with a capacity of 120 students.

Overall, the programme served as an informative and motivational platform that encouraged participants to adopt responsible digital behavior, enhance technical competence, and contribute to nation-building through ethical and secure use of technology.

5. Key Highlights

- The Vice-Chancellor welcomed the guests, thanked and appreciated all the faculty members and the department, spoke about the workshop, and discussed the plan to create a new computer lab with a capacity of 120 students.
- The Chief Guest spoke about the MoU signed between their organization and the university.
- The Special Guest talked about the dharma (duty) of engineers, saying: *“Your obligation as an engineer is to protect user data, ensure system integrity, and act with honesty. This will make you a better engineer.”*
- The guests also spoke about transparency and fairness, stating:
“True knowledge and education liberate people. Knowledge should empower and enlighten, not obscure or control.”
- A discussion on privacy and data protection took place, emphasizing that **user data should be treated with the highest respect**.
- The Chief Guest highlighted that market demand today is not just for degrees but for skills. He also discussed emerging careers in the field of data security and mentioned the concept of a **Zero Trust Policy**.
- The Director of the Faculty spoke about the value of knowledge and its importance in nation-building. He emphasized development with integrity, morality, and security in focus, and stated that **cybersecurity is not an option, but a necessity**.
