MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING Between

Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Language University, Lucknow And Analyze Infotech, Lucknow

Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti Language University. Lucknow (hereafter referred to as KMCLU) and Analyze Infotech, Aliganj, Lucknow (hereafter referred to as Analyze Infotech) herewith sign a memorandum of understanding on 25.1.2.23which reads as follows:

PREAMBLE:

ARTICLE 1: INTRODUCTION OF PARTICIPANTS

The University aims to achieve excellence in language, research and innovation that supports the students in becoming productive, responsible, ethical, creative and compassionate members of the society.

ARTICLE 2: AREAS OF COOPERATION

2.1 Both parties agree to encourage the following activities in particular and to promote cooperation in the following areas:

A. Responsibilities of Analyze Infotech and/or its program sponsors/partners:

- a) Joint organizations of such programs which fills the gaps between academia and industry on latest trends in Software Industry.
- b) Assitance by Analyze InfoTech to KMCLU for organizing Faculty Development Programs.

B. Responsibilities of Institution:

- a) Learner identification: The Institute will identify learners, volunteers and instructors who may participate in program(s) offered by Analyze Infotech. The institute will identify the learners who meet the criteria for the program as shared by Analyze Infotech.
- b) **Support with orientation sessions**: Institute will support Analyze Infotech conduct orientation sessions for all stakeholders.
- c) Publication of program calendars and goals: Institute will publish, a program calendar for all its participants.
- d) Support with computer labs and classrooms: Institute will make its labs available to learners. It will make classrooms and/or audio-visual equipment available for face-to-face sessions, whenever required.
- e) Support with attendance: Institute will ensure that program participants enthusiastically participate in chosen programs, with minimum attendance as agreed between the Parties.
- f) Support with assessments: Institute will ensure that assessments carried out onsite and offsite are proctored and professionally managed.
- g) No fees: Institute will not charge any extra fees from learners for participation in Analyze Infotechprograms.

ARTICLE 3: FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 3.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other.
- 3.2 Each Party shall bear its own cost and expenses in the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding.

ARTICLE 4: EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MOU

- 4.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective from the date of signatures of both parties, or if the dates vary, then the date of the later signature.
- 4.2 The MoU will be valid for a period of five years from the date of signature.
- 4.3 This MoU may be extended with the written consent of both parties.

ARTICLE 5: CONFIDENTIALITY

During the tenure of the MoU and afterwards, unless both parties permit the disclosure, both organization will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchanged under the scope of projects covered under this MoU.

ARTICLE 6: AMENDMENTS

No amendment or modification of this MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by all the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this MoU. The modification shall be effective from the date on which they are made unless otherwise agreed to.

ARTICLE 7: FORCE MAJEURE

Both the parties shall have no liability in respect of any delay in carrying of the activities or failure to carry out the activities under this MoU caused due to any acts of the government, or any circumstances outside the reasonable control of the parties hereto.

ARTICLE 8: NON-BINDING NATURE OF THIS MOU

The MOU is not binding on either Party and each is working with the other out of sheer good-will and for the benefit of the learners.

ARTICLE 9: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

All disputes and differences concerning the validity, scope, meaning interpretation or effect of this MoUor any dispute or disagreement between the parties for any matter relating to this memorandum, Registrar KMCLU and Representative Analyze Infotech will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility. In case of any dispute which cannot be settled by mutual discussion an arbitrator may be appointed by each party.

ARTICLE 10: TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either party with a minimum of Thirty (30) days written notice. Activities in progress at the time termination of this Memorandum of Understandingshall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed.

ARTICLE 11: PROGRAM CALENDAR & ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The SPOCs from both Parties will work with their respective internal stakeholders to develop a calendar for the program(s) roll-out at the start of every year. This calendar will then be synchronized and published for use by everyone.

ARTICLE 12: COORDINATORS

Both the Parties shall appoint a suitable team who will serve as a primary point of contact on all matters related to program roll-out. Individual learners and teachers may be in touch with corresponding trainers, mentors, advisors and peers during program roll-out. However, all the matters related to the execution of this MOU shall reside with the signing authority.
