PREAMBLE:

ARTICLE 1: INTRODUCTION OF PARTICIPANTS

ARTICLE 2: AREAS OF COOPERATION

The above-mentioned parties mutually agree on the following:

A. Responsibilities of UPTOSKILLS (Second Party)

Second Party would be the Skills development Training & Placement provider for all the students of First Party.

The above mentioned parties mutually agree on the following:

- A. Second Party would be the Skills development Training/Placement provider for First Party. Details of Courses are given below-
- IT Skills - Python/Django, Data Science, Artificial Intelligence, Deep Learning, Machine Learning, Java With Spring Boot & Microservices, Big Data, Hadoop, Cloud Computing (Sales force & AWS), Networking (Cisco & Microsoft Module), Android/IOSMEAN/MERN, Angularjs, ReactJS, Microsoft Technologies(.NET), Software Quality Testing(Manual/Automation/Selenium), DBMS(D2K & DBA) etc.
 - Electrical & Electronics Skills - Embedded System, IOT, Arduino, Matlab, PLC, SCADA, VLSI, (VHDL & VERILOG), Solar Power plant Engineering etc.
 - Manufacturing Software Skills - Autocad 2D & 3D, CREO, Catia, Solidworks, CNC Programming, Part Design, Autocad Civil, Staad Pro, 3DS Max, Revit Arch., Unigraphics, Primavera, ANSYS, Piping Design etc.
 - Oil & Gas Industry Skills - Aspen plus, Process Design Engineering, Troubleshooting in plants, HYSYS, Piping Design etc.
 - Administrative Skills - HR, IT Recruitment, Financial Analysis Etc..

- B. Second Party Provide academic interaction by delivering Special Lectures at First Party on topics of relevance to modern Industry.



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Deliverables from Second Party

- i. Both the parties mutually agree on a training module that would be delivered by Second Party.
- ii. Industrial Training Certificate (for Online /Offline /Hybrid mode) will be given by Second Party.
- iii. Training timing will be decided as per mutual understanding.
- iv. Placement assistance would be delivered by Second party.

B. Responsibilities of Institution (First Party):

2.2 First party will carry out the training of the proposed module for the students.

- i. First Party would be providing the lab infrastructure and lab assistance required for the training program at no extra cost.
- ii. Banners for the activities will be placed inside the campus.
- iii. Activities will be shared on University's social media and print media for the welfare of the students.
- iv. First party will depute one person (SPOC) from organization to coordinate with second party for smooth functioning.

2.3 Infrastructure Requirements:-

- i. Seminar Room /Class Rooms equipped with the LCD Projector.
- ii. Microphone and Speaker.
- iii. Computer Lab of 40 Nodes. (Actual figure depends on the number of students and the specialization subject selected).
- iv. Room for accommodation of guests.(if available)

ARTICLE 3: FINANCIALARRANGEMENTS

- 3.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other.
- 3.2 Each Party shall bear its own cost and expenses in the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding. If any financial liabilities arises it will be bear by mutual terms and agreement made by both parties at that time.

ARTICLE 4: EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MOU

- 4.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective from the date of signatures of



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both parties, or if the dates vary, then the date of the later signature.

4.2 The MoU will be valid for a period of five years from the date of signature.

4.3 The MOU can be renewed after 5 year subject to imparting satisfactory training deliverables by Second Party.

ARTICLE 5: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

5.1 Both Parties undertake that they shall not infringe upon any copyright or in exclusive possession of the respective Parties. Both parties shall obtain permission in writing for the usage of any logo, motif, emblem, or any other intellectual property right vested in the respective Parties to be used in connection with the implementation of the present MoU from the respective Party. Each Party is the sole owner of such intellectual property.

5.2 Neither Party may use the other party's intellectual property rights without the prior consent of that Party. Nothing contained in this MoU is intended to, or shall be construed to grant to either Party any license or right regarding the other Party's Intellectual Property Rights.

5.3 In case of research results obtained through joint activities, the grant of intellectual property rights will be sought by both the parties jointly and once granted these rights will jointly be owned by the parties on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

5.4 Any expenditure towards filing, maintaining and securing of IPR, development of the product and revenue towards license fee and royalty shall be shared on case to case basis in mutual consultation between both institutions under a separate agreement.

ARTICLE 6: PUBLICATIONS

Experts/Faculty and scholars/members of both the Organizations may work jointly on publications. The Royalty / Intellectual Property Rights, if any, will be shared jointly on mutually agreed terms between the Parties through a separate specific agreement.

ARTICLE 7: CONFIDENTIALITY

During the tenure of the MoU and after wards, unless both parties permit the disclosure, both parties will maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of all the information and data exchanged under the scope of projects covered under this MoU.

ARTICLE 8: AMENDMENTS

No amendment or modification of this MoU shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by



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all the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically stating the same to be an amendment of this MoU. The modification shall be effective from the date on which they are made unless otherwise agreed to.

ARTICLE 9: FORCE MAJEURE

Both the parties shall have no liability in respect of any delay in carrying of the activities or failure to carry out the activities under this MoU caused due to any acts of the government, or any circumstances outside the reasonable control of the parties hereto.

ARTICLE 10: NON-BINDING NATURE OF THIS MOU

The MOU is not binding on either Party and each is working with the other out of sheer goodwill and for the benefit of the learners.

ARTICLE 11: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

All disputes and differences concerning the validity, scope, meaning interpretation or effect of this MoU or any dispute or disagreement between the parties for any matter relating or his memorandum, Registrar KMCLU and Representative Uptoskills will jointly resolve the dispute in as pirito find ependence, mutual respect and shared responsibility. In case of any dispute which cannot be settled by mutual discussion an arbitrator may be appointed by each party.

ARTICLE 12: TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either party with a minimum of Thirty (30) days written notice. Activities in progress at the time termination of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be permitted to conclude as planed unless otherwise agreed.

ARTICLE 13: PROGRAM CALENDAR & ACADEMIC CALENDAR

13.1 Program Schedule:-

The detailed contents of the program for the year 2023 have been discussed and agreed upon by both the parties:

- i. In case of any changes/updates in the training program, the same would be intimated to First Party and inculcated in the training after their approval.
- ii. Necessary changes will be made in time table. (if required)

13.2 The SPOCs from both Parties will work with their respective internal stake holders to

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develop a calendar for the program(s) roll-out at the start of every quarter. This calendar will then be synchronized and published for use by everyone.

ARTICLE 14: COORDINATORS

Both the Parties shall appoint suitable team who will serve as a primary point of contact on all matters related to program roll-out. At KMCLU, the coordinator will be Mrs. Nidhi Sonkar and at Upto skills the coordinator will be Ms. Eliza Rastogi Both the Coordinators shall notify their counterparts in case a new person is named to their position.


However, all the matters related to the execution of this MOU shall reside with the signing authority.

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
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
