

5.4 In case of research results obtained through joint activities, the grant of intellectual property rights will be sought by both the parties jointly and once granted these rights will jointly be owned by the parties

on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

5.5 In case of research results obtained through joint activities under this MoU, both parties will apply as co – applicants for the protection of IPR subject to exclusive rights of both the parties to commercialize the technology jointly on mutually acceptable terms and conditions.

5.6 Any expenditure towards filing, maintain and securing of IPR, development of the product and revenue towards license fee and royalty shall be shared on case to case basis in mutual consultation between both the institutions under a separate agreement.

ARTICLE 6: PUBLICATIONS
