



General Guidelines for PhD Admission Interview (RET-2024)

Dear Candidates,

This is to inform with pleasure that the University is going to conduct the interview of the candidates who have successfully qualified the written test i.e. RET-2024 conducted on May 11, 2024. The final merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the interview as well as in the written test. The candidate will be eligible to take admission in the Pre-Ph.D. Course work on the basis of the final compiled list of merit. At the time of the interview you are required to bring all the original copies of your educational documents along with one set of self-attested photocopy. Further, you have to present your candidature in front of the interview panel along with three copies of the proposed synopsis, application form for Pre-PhD Course Work (Annexure i) and a power point presentation of your proposed research topic/area.

Kindly report as per the given schedule:

Admission to Pre PhD Course Work will be as per the criteria mentioned below and in the light of UGC, PhD Guidelines 2022 and the PhD Ordinances-2023 of Khwaja Moinuddin Chishtli Language University, Lucknow. The criteria are as follows:

1. The candidate must carry three copies of proposed research work (synopsis) and a power point presentation of the same.
2. The interview will be of 30 marks.
3. The final selection of candidates for Ph.D. Programme shall be based on 70% weightage to the Research Entrance Test (RET) and 30% weightage to performance in the interview/viva-voce (including weightage to JRF/NET/ UP-SLET).
4. Kindly report 01 hour before the interview schedule.
5. No TA/DA will be provided by the University for the Interview.
6. All the admissions will be completed after the approval of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, KMCLU on the recommendation of Ph.D. Coordinator.
7. Relevant original documents for verification along with a set of self-attested photocopy. Copy of UGC NET/JRF certificate also, if claimed by the candidate.
8. 75% of attendance is compulsory to complete the course work.
9. Candidates who are working in any organization will submit a 'No Objection Certificate' from the head of the institution before taking admission to the Pre-PhD course work.
10. Pre-PhD Course Work is expected to commence in the month of July, 2024
11. After registration if any candidate leaves the Pre-PhD Course Work, then no fee will be returned back.
