Objective of the Seminar

The speaker highlighted that Ambedkar believed social progress was impossible without the empowerment of women and worked tirelessly toward this goal.

Prof. Snehi elaborated on several key contributions of Dr. Ambedkar:

- **Constitutional Rights for Women:** Dr. Ambedkar ensured the inclusion of equal rights for women in the Indian Constitution. He fought for gender equality in legal, political, and social domains.
- **Hindu Code Bill:** One of his most progressive initiatives, the Hindu Code Bill, aimed to give women equal rights in matters of marriage, divorce, and inheritance. Although it faced resistance and wasn’t passed during his time, it laid the foundation for future reforms.
- **Education and Employment:** Dr. Ambedkar emphasized the importance of education for women. He encouraged women to become educated, self-reliant, and economically independent.
- **Social Reform Movements:** As part of his social reform efforts, he worked against practices like child marriage and the denial of education to women. He motivated women from marginalized communities to rise against oppression.
