- ❑ The cell facilitates the utilization of grants and timely submission of Utilization Certificate.

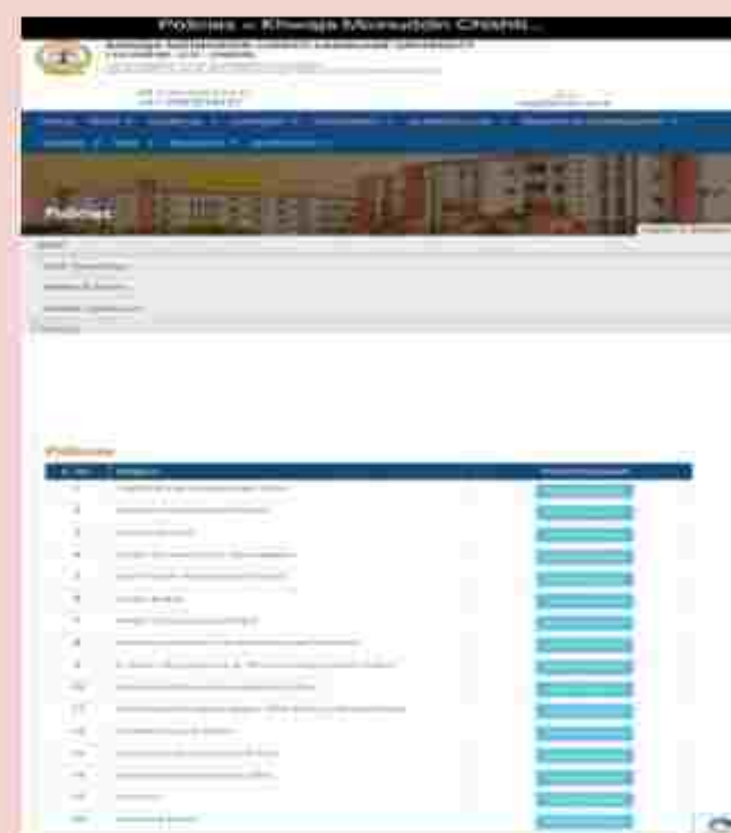
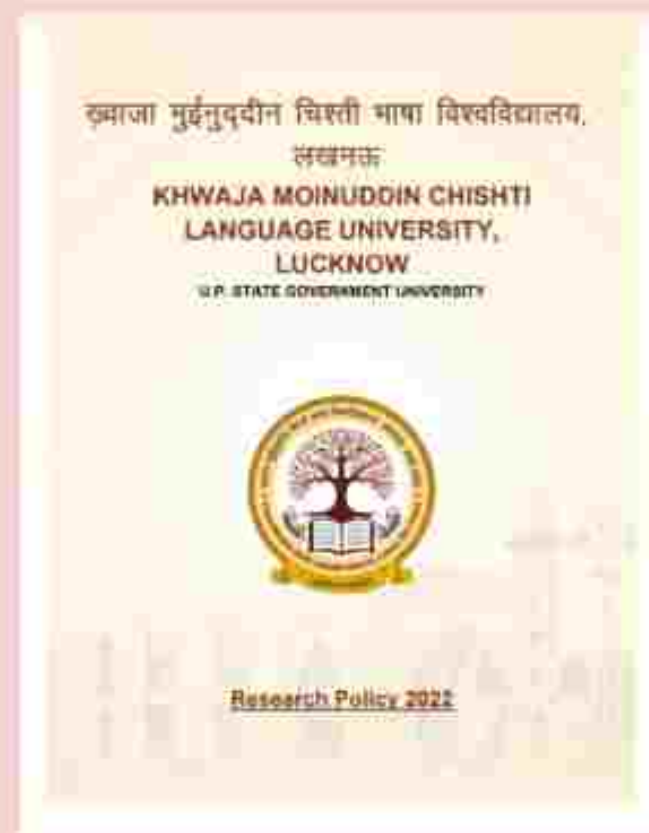


RESEARCH POLICY

Research Facilities of the university are frequently updated. The University has a number of well equipped **Language, Science, Computer and AI ,Robotics laboratories as well as Media Lab** for the research scholars

- ❑ Upgraded laboratories, incubation centres, library, research centres, centres of excellence are available.
- ❑ Full-fledged **Ph.D. programme in the session 2018-19** –in the Faculty of Arts and Humanities, Science, Commerce and Social Sciences
- ❑ **Separate research centres** have been set-up in various departments of the University, to promote innovation and novel research ideas.
- ❑ The University has a well-established **Research and Development Cell and every Department has a Research Advisory Committee and Departmental Research Committee**, which conducts regular meetings to review the research proposals of scholars.
- ❑ Outcome of continuous upgradation of research facilities of the University is evident from the establishment of **11 Centres of Excellence, 16 Research Projects and 01 Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Shodhpeeth** by the Department of Higher Education, Uttar Pradesh, ICSSR, ICHR, etc Further, two students from the Faculty of Engineering and Technology have received a research project grants from the Council of Science & Technology, Uttar Pradesh
- ❑ To enable innovative research work in the field of Science and Technology, **state-of-the-art laboratories** were established in 2020-21.
- ❑ University has established an Incubation Centre –**'Awadh Incubation Foundation'** in the year 2021-22, to encourage the research & innovation pursuits of the students.
- ❑ **The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Cell** has been set up & Innovation and Startup policy formulated to encourage filing and publication of

Laboratory Infrastructure Upgradation Timeline

- **2020: Initial Infrastructure**
 - * Two well-equipped computer labs were established.
 - * Each lab consisted of 30 computer systems, supporting core computing subjects and project-based learning.
 - * These labs served as the primary hub for practical sessions, coding exercises, and internal assessments.
- **2022: Expansion to Meet Growing Demand**
 - * A third computer lab with 30 additional systems was set up.
 - * This expansion was aimed at accommodating an increasing number of students and the growing demand for lab-based courses.
- **2023: Further Augmentation**
 - * A fourth computer lab was added, also equipped with 30 systems.
 - * With this, the department's total computing capacity rose significantly, allowing for parallel sessions and specialized training.

2025: Establishment of AI Lab

- **A dedicated Artificial Intelligence Lab was established to promote innovation, research, and hands-on experience in emerging technologies.**
- **The AI Lab currently houses 11 advanced equipment items, including:**

 - * **Sensor Boards for real-time data collection and automation**
 - * **FCB (Flight Control Board) Simulator for drone technology training**
 - * **Drones for aerial computing and real-world application projects**

 - * **Additional AI and robotics components to support multi-disciplinary learning**
 - * **This lab provides a dynamic environment for students to engage in projects involving AI, IoT, robotics, and simulation.**

Research Scholar should be first author of the paper to be presented as an oral presentation. The research work should be the outcome of their research work done in their institute of specific duration.
