- The cell facilitates the utilization of grants and timely submission of Utilization Certificate.




#### RESEARCH POLICY

## **Laboratory Infrastructure Upgradation Timeline**

- 2020: Initial Infrastructure
  - \* Two well-equipped computer labs were established.
  - \* Each lab consisted of 30 computer systems, supporting core computing subjects and project-based learning.
  - \*These labs served as the primary hub for practical sessions, coding exercises, and internal assessments.
- 2022: Expansion to Meet Growing Demand
  - \* A third computer lab with 30 additional systems was set up.
  - \* This expansion was aimed at accommodating an increasing number of students and the growing demand for lab-based courses.

#### 2023: Further Augmentation

- \* A fourth computer lab was added, also equipped with 30 systems.
- \* With this, the department's total computing capacity rose significantly, allowing for parallel sessions and specialized training.

#### 2025: Establishment of AI Lab

- A dedicated Artificial Intelligence Lab was established to promote innovation, research, and hands-on experience in emerging technologies.
- The AI Lab currently houses 11 advanced equipment items, including:

  - \* Robonova Humanoid Robot
  - \* Sensor Boards for real-time data collection and automation
  - \* FCB (Flight Control Board) Simulator for drone technology training
  - \* Drones for aerial computing and real-world application projects
  - \* 3D Printer for prototyping and design innovation
  - \* Additional AI and robotics components to support multi-disciplinary learning
  - \* This lab provides a dynamic environment for students to engage in projects involving AI, IoT, robotics, and simulation.
