To encourage a dynamic engagement between curricular and extracurricular learning experiences and strive for positive social implications we have a student-centric curriculum. To achieve this time bound vision and mission the skilled and multitasking faculties are selected by recruitment committee with proper selection procedures. Upgraded classrooms like; an interdisciplinary science laboratory, language laboratory, and a recording studio for producing video/audio lectures provide a wide spectrum of advanced learning to the students. Library with digital accession for the students as well as faculty members with wi-fi connection helps to enhance the global knowledge of students. The University has already made arrangements and issued instructions to incorporate *Blended Learning methods* in its Teaching-Learning process. Each department carries out 25% of its workload in online mode. Completion of the sevenstory building will be soon in the future and will be used to develop more advanced and digital smart classes for interactive studies which can be run in dual mode. Working gym and sports ground facility is available for holistic development of students. Girls and boy's hostels in the university premises are running and teachers play an integral role in the management and decision-making bodies in this. In addition to their teaching responsibilities, they also participate in administrative and executive processes: As teacher representatives in the governing body as the Dean, HOD, nodal officer, public information officer, academic coordinator, teacher-in-charge, conveners, and members of several committees of the university council.

To nurture an ecosystem that promotes democratic values, inclusiveness of diverse peoples and cultures, and freedom of expression and creativity we have a cultural committee. *To instill a culture of sensitivity to gender issues* and identities we have a grievances committee.
